THE SIR FRANCIS DRAKE CHANNEL BECKONS

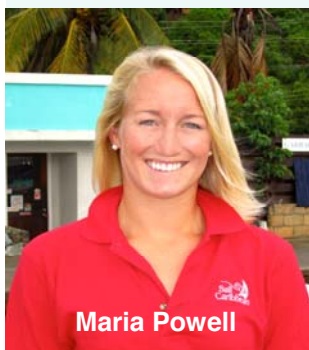

THE FREEDOM TO ISLAND HOP

When taking *Opal Bella* out for a sail, your captain will meet you on the dock 20 minutes ahead of departure. Become familiar with your boat, have a safety briefing, then untie the docklines and sail out from Manchioneel Bay into the Sir Francis Drake Channel. With its close proximity to many of the islands, **Cooper Island** is the ideal place to depart and explore the beautiful wildlife and scenery of the BVI. On a short sail to Salt Island, snorkel the famous *Wreck of the Rhone*, protected within a Marine National Park and teeming with colorful sea life. You might also enjoy a scenic hike to the top of Salt. Gybe further downwind and you'll find The Indians and Caves at Norman Island, two more sites for incredible snorkeling. Another great option from Cooper is to tack upwind to the Baths on Virgin Gorda and explore the massive boulders that litter the coast. With a full day, there are many options for your itinerary—just tell your captain what you want to do!

When participating in our ASA Basic Keelboat course, you'll mix instructional time and sailing into your day. Your classroom will be both the beach and *Opal Bella* as your instructor walks you through every aspect of maneuvering and handling a small keelboat. On the last day, celebrate your accomplishments with a sail to Marina Cay to have your picture taken in the classic British old red telephone box. Each day will be packed with activity and by the end you will feel confident and able to command a 26-foot boat!
